In the decades after moving to West Philadelphia the church saw the community become increasingly marginalized.

Berry laid out several methods to meet the needs of her congregation, with a focus on caring for youth. Collaborative workshops, services, and activities with local churches and Drexel University (such as Allied Youth Service) included educational programs, sports, and clubs.

The church also hosted soup kitchens and events to celebrate and educate about Black history.
